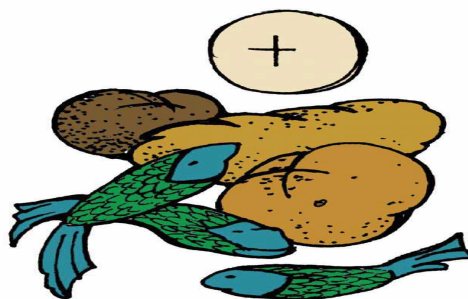

PART 13 The Diocese of Hamilton is conducting the One Heart, One Soul Campaign to raise money for every parish in the diocese and for shared ministries

Update—Campaign starts strong. The early returns to the "One Heart, One Soul" Campaign are promising! Through mid-May, 14 Pilot Wave parishes had raised a total of more than \$2.5 million and an additional \$1.6 million had been pledged by other diocesan supporters and organizations. That total is about 12% of the Campaign's \$35 million goal. The Pilot Wave will run through June and 3 larger, additional waves will follow as the Campaign gathers steam and continues through early 2021. More than 30 parishes and a number of mission churches are taking part in the next wave and preparations at those parishes are underway. Kickoff Weekend is tentatively set for September. Pastors at those parishes gathered on May 15 for a lunch at which Pilot Wave pastors shared their experiences.
